## APPLICATION INFORMATION

**AzProp G Select™**, labeled for the control of more than 25 troublesome turfgrass diseases, is most effective when applied during favorable conditions, prior to disease development. Apply **AzProp G Select** at rates and timings outlined in the label, using all types of ground-application spreader equipment except belly grinder equipment. Properly calibrated equipment providing good coverage is essential for effective disease control. **NOTE:** Ask about our **AzProp G Select** spreader settings flyer for important application information.

Higher use rates in the rate range and/or shorter intervals may be required during heavy infection pressure, with highly susceptible varieties, or when environmental conditions favorable to disease exist. Repeat applications at specified intervals for as long as needed to manage diseases.

**AzProp G Select** should be part of an overall disease management strategy whenever the use of a fungicide is required. Cultural practices known to reduce disease development (such as fertilization) should be followed.
