LABELED USES

- Non-crop areas, including airports, barrow ditches, communication transmission lines, electric power and utility rights-of-way, fencerows, gravel pits, industrial sites, military sites, mining and drilling areas, oil and gas pads, non-irrigation ditch banks, parking lots, petroleum tank farms, pipelines, roadsides, railroads, storage areas, dry stormwater retention areas, substations, and unimproved rough turf grasses
- Natural areas (open space) for example, campgrounds, parks, prairie management, trailheads and trails, recreation areas, wildlife openings, and wildlife habitat and management areas including seasonally dry flood plains, deltas, marshes, prairie potholes, or vernal pools

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How should I apply Malibu on pasture/rangeland for best results?

- Usage rate: 3.0-14.0 fl oz/A, depending on the weed species. Refer to the label for the appropriate rate range and any usage restrictions for the weed(s) needing control.
- Malibu may be applied as a broadcast spray by ground or aerial equipment or as a spot application to control weeds including, but not limited to, those listed on the product label.
- When a rate range is given, use the higher rate to control weeds at advanced growth stages or when under less-than-favorable growing conditions.
- For optimum uptake and translocation, avoid mowing, haying, shredding, burning, or soil disturbance in treated areas for at least 14 days following application.
- To maximize and extend the benefits of weed control provided by Malibu, it is important that other vegetation management practices, including proper grazing management, biological control agents, replanting, fertilization, prescribed fire, etc., be used in appropriate sequences and combinations to further alleviate the adverse effects of weeds on desirable plant species and to promote development of desired plant communities.
- Consult with appropriate state or local water authorities before applying this product around public waters. State or local public agencies may require permits.

What restrictions do I need to observe when using Malibu on pasture and rangeland?

- DO NOT use grasses treated with Malibu in the preceding 18 months for hay intended for export outside the United States.
- Hay from areas treated with Malibu in the preceding 18 months CANNOT be distributed or made available for sale off the farm or ranch where harvested unless allowed by supplemental labeling.
- Hay from areas treated with Malibu in the preceding 18 months CANNOT be used for silage, haylage, baleage, and green chop unless allowed by supplemental labeling.
- DO NOT move hay made from grass treated with Malibu within the preceding 18 months off farm unless allowed by supplemental labeling.
- DO NOT use hay or straw from areas treated with Malibu within the preceding 18 months or manure from animals feeding on hay treated with Malibu in compost.
- DO NOT use grasses treated with Malibu in the preceding 18 months for seed production.
- Refer to product label for additional restrictions for haying, grazing, and manure uses, and crop rotation restrictions
